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The children have now settled down well into the school routines after the holidays and they have been working well. In our Early Years forest school on Monday the children were thinking about birds, they did some bird spotting, made nests and birds to go in them.

In science the older children were thinking about eating a balanced diet and nutrition whilst the younger children were categorising animals. This is part of our science learning theme this half term on animals, including humans. In computing the children have begun work on recording audio and making their own podcasts. In music, the children enjoyed playing instruments - they needed to listen to their peers whilst they played in order to play in time with each other.

This week in maths the year 4s had their turn for doing practical maths on Holy Island. Meanwhile, year 3 did a parallel lesson at Lowick. We were investigating who has the biggest yard (Lowick or Holy Island) and by how much. This involved estimating skills and accurate measurement in metres. The children also did work in history on the Ancient Greeks' method of sending secret messages - very exciting!
